**2012 SCHOLARSHIP AVAILABILITY**

To encourage students to consider careers in manufacturing, CEN will once again be making available \$1,000.00 scholarships to be awarded to applicants who are:

1. High school seniors graduating in 2012 and accepted at an accredited two or four year college, university, or trade school; or
2. College students enrolled in an accredited two or four year college, university or trade school; and
3. Students planning to enroll in a major which can lead to qualifying for a position with a manufacturer; and
4. Residents of one of the following eleven Capital Region counties: Albany, Columbia, Fulton, Greene, Montgomery, Rensselaer, Saratoga, Schenectady, Schoharie, Warren, and Washington.
